- Matters arising
  - a. Frocester George effluent update
  - b. Defibrillator update

- Finance
  - a. Bank account - £4,272.11 + £138.69
  - b. We have not received payment of the Cambridge Solar Power invoiced for the community benefit of £204.02, still trying to find out from the accounts team.
  - c. Four months British Gas electricity bill for the red phone box has been paid £6.49.
  - d. The Local Regeneration Handbook – ordered from GAPTC £19.50.
  - e. Mid Cotswold Tracks and Trails Group have been sent £30.
  - f. Still to decide how to spend £479.99 on transparency funded computer but GDPR will require it.

- General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

*Sue and Anita (GAPTC) gave an overview of their understanding of the GDPR to date as well as what councils should expect from the new audit scheme in November. This legislation affects the whole of the EU and countries trading with EU members so this is big! So much is still being discussed in parliament and the whole of the UK is holding its breath waiting for details to emerge, so don't panic, just check the information you hold on living persons and audit why you are holding it. If you don't need it, get rid of it.*

*If you think about it as an individual, we are all going to be bombarded by all organisations, both public and private, with requests for permission to retain information and details of what it is used for. We can hardly wait! So the message is Keep Calm and Get Shredding! The latest NALC briefing, dated August 2017, is on our website in the documents section, under D. As soon as more information emerges we will share it with you.*

A quote from DM Payroll Services Ltd suggests £150 a year. GAPTC – pricing not clear yet

- Highways
  - a. Pat and Colin Harris who work for the Mid Cotswold Tracks & Trails Group say £30 or whatever we can afford. It was not clear if the cost which was £241 was to be shared by four parishes.
  - b. Lisa Ellis – road safety in Frocester inquiry said we should speak to highways, highways said we should speak to the police, now liaising with the Gloucestershire Road Safety Community Hub <https://roadsafety-gloucestershire.org.uk/>.
- Planning
  - a. S.17/2344/LBC Change of use of Coach House and erection of glass extension to the Coach House, new gates and entrance within the curtilage of a listed building. Consent granted 19 Dec 2017.
  - b. Frocester Manor – HFT are not allowed to tell us, Land Registry want £59 to tell us who the owners are, are we curious enough to spend the money?
