- General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

All member councils were sent a copy of the NALC toolkit which contains model policies and templates to use. NALC and SLCC are working together to clarify the situation on the role of the Data Protection Officer on a national basis and with the Bill going through the House of Commons recently, we hope to have more clarification soon. Until then review the information you hold regarding living individuals and destroy it if you no longer need to hold it. As soon as we have further information we will share it with you.

02-March-2018 The National Association of Local Councils (NALC) published a parliamentary briefing on the data protection bill that sought to clarify how small parish councils were to fund the disproportionate cost of the GDPR.
