

FROCESTER PARISH COUNCIL

MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON WEDNESDAY 21ST MARCH 2018 AT 7.30PM AT CRICKET CLUB

Present were Cllrs. Bill Flude (Chair), Wendy Hawkins (vice Chair), David Holpin, Jane Davis and Peter Williams.

1. The Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 17th January 2018 were read, approved by councillors and signed by the Chair.
2. In matters arising
 - a. The councillors were informed that the wet weather had delayed the start on the development of the Frocester George effluent soak away.
 - b. The parish council has agreed to fund a managed lease scheme for a defibrillator to be installed in the telephone kiosk.
 - c. The application for the War Memorial grant has been made, the council is now waiting for a response.
3. Finance
 - a. The bank accounts currently stand at £4,242.11 + £264.98.
 - b. The council has received payment from Cambridge Solar Power for the community benefit of £204.02.
 - c. The Local Regeneration Handbook, ordered from GAPTC, has been received and offers many interesting thoughts on community development.
4. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
 - a. The parish has received a copy of the NALC toolkit which contains model policies and templates to use in support of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The advice from NALC is to review all information held by the parish council regarding living individuals and destroy if it is no longer needed.
5. Planning
 - a. Councillors were informed the land registry title deeds for Frocester Manor state that the new proprietor is New Dawn Homes Limited of Cheltenham. It was agreed that the council would wish to know more about the plans for this very prominent site in the village.
6. Any other business
 - a. A village litter pick was planned for Monday April 9th.

The next meeting was set for Wednesday 2nd May 2018 at 7.30pm in the cricket club. The meeting closed at 8.30pm.
