MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON WEDNESDAY 21ST NOVEMBER 2018 AT 7.30PM AT CRICKET CLUB

1. Apologies none
2. The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 26th September 2018 were read, approved by councillors and signed by the Chairman.
3. Matters arising
 - a. Cllr. Williams asked for the minutes of each parish meeting to be published only after they had been approved by councillors. The adopted procedure of publishing the minutes in SPAN before approval has now been abandoned.
 - b. Frocester George effluent update - the new treatment plant is working, and the foul air is no longer evident.
 - c. It was agreed that the red telephone box would be painted, and the defibrillator installed when other commitments allow.
 - d. War memorial refurbishment update - Stroud Councillor Loraine Patrick, or other, will be contacted for funds.
