- 1. Apologies None
- 2. Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022 were read, approved by councillors, and signed by the Chairman.
- 3. Matters arising
  - a. The councillors were updated on the meeting with Siobhan Baillie on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2023 with respect to the proposed Frocester Estate solar farm at which it was agreed that correspondence between Siobhan Baillie and Novus Renewables could help make Novus aware of the complexity of such a development.
  - b. The meeting with Gary Wilson, the Local Highways Manager, on Thursday 24th at Coaley Peak discussed Frocester Hill road safety. With eight accidents in one month the proposed April safety improvements should be amended to consider speed limits, signage and other methods of control. It was agreed that Cllr.
